With the bracing North Sea lapping round the corner, Walberswick is

a slice of pure seaside nostalgia, positively begging for seaside walks or goose-pimpling dips.

The Anchor is the icing on the cake – Tudorbethan on the outside and bright, comfortable and modern on the inside. This Adnams-owned pub has swiftly become renowned for both its great collection of cask beers and its superb food. The menu is cheerfully small (a sure sign of freshness); take, for instance, the meatloaf served with home-made piccalilli, freshly caught local fish, or rare breed beef.

On sunny days, decamp to the patio with its views over the sea and the coast stretching southwards to the lost town of Dunwich. Whether you want to mull over the day in the company of a peerless pint of Broadside or explore the pub's culinary delights, the Anchor is a treasure.

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
