‘Brilliant and very accommodating service, great food, local produce, the list could go on’ enthuses an admirer of the Dorbers’ Art and Crafts pub, which has been refurbished with ‘good taste’. In the kitchen Sophie Dorber has set out her stall with a short, contemporary and appealing modern menu based on fresh, seasonal (occasionally own-grown) produce. Simplicity is a keynote, evident in smoked mackerel terrine with horseradish cream, and seared scallops with pancetta and Jerusalem artichoke purée. If the food appears to play safe, however, it is certainly not lacking in character. Ginger, greens and roast parsnips make perfect partners for five-spice belly pork, and a cardamom rice pudding with quince syrup constituted ‘a perfect marriage’ for one visitor. Mark Dorber is something of a beer guru, so check out the pumps and range of bottles, and there’s plenty of good drinking to be had on the wine list, which starts at £12.50
